

Study Overview Highlights


In this ever-changing academic environment, the Time4Learning Quarterly Survey measures the motivations and opinions of homeschooling families throughout their journey. Families who have registered since May 2020 were invited to participate and will provide their honest responses to various questions throughout 2022. These are the first results.

This survey included 994 Time4Learning families.


Key Takeaway #1

Almost 96% of those surveyed will continue to homeschool with Time4Learning through the next three months.

Q: Are you satisfied with your child's homeschool education? (n=994)




Q: Do you plan to continue homeschooling with Time4Learning through the next three months? (n=994)



Key Takeaway #2

COVID concerns continue to dominate motivations to homeschool, with parents citing safety, academic control, and dissatisfaction with local school pandemic responses, among other factors.
